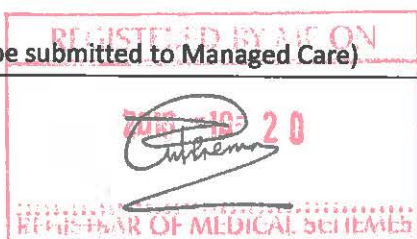

Measure and ICD – 10 codes	Care , screening, test
<b>Full medical examination</b>

<b>Child Health</b>	
<b>All child immunisation provided by the Department of Health for children six (6) years old and younger.</b>	As per DOH age schedule as per the Road to Health chart
<b>Female Health (Women and Adolescent Girls)</b>	
<b>Cervical cancer screening ICD: Z 12.4</b> For all females aged 21-64 years old, <i>except for those women who have had a complete hysterectomy with no residual cervix</i>	PAP smear test once every third year
<b>Breast cancer screening ICD: Z12.3 and ICD: Z01.6</b> Mammogram: all women aged 40- 69 years old	Once every 2 years, unless motivated.
<b>Contraceptives ICD: Z 30</b>	As recommended by NDOH
<b>Dental Health</b>	
<b>Consultation and topical fluoride application for children aged 0-6 years</b>	Annually
<b>Topical fluoride application for children aged 7- 18 years</b>	Annually
<b>Caries risk assessment for children aged 0-14 years</b> (Clinical information to be submitted to Managed Care)	Once every second year
<b>Periodontal disease and caries risk assessment for adults 19 years of age and above</b> (Clinical information to be submitted to Managed Care)	Once every second year

<b>HIV Counseling and Testing</b>	
HIV Counseling pre- counseling	Annually
HCT Consultation Rapid testing and post counseling	Annually
HIV Testing Elisa: 3932 Confirmation test: Western Blot (payable after HCT or ELISA tests)	Annually
<b>Other</b>	
Flu vaccine	Annually
Hib titer for 60 years and older (Serology: IgM: specific antibody titer)	Annually
Prostate cancer screening For all males aged between 50 and 75 years	Annually
Glaucoma screening	Once every third year; unless motivated
Circumcision	Subject to clinical protocols
Post Trauma debriefing session Only for active principal members of SAPS, utilising the psycho-social network	Four sessions per year.
